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Executive Summary

On the 15th of September three tests were conducted on the Alsysco Crystal Balustrade at the Steel Studio factory located in Linbro Park Johannesburg. The three tests were conducted to test the balustrade against loading requirements outlined in SANS10160-2 namely a 1.5kN/m Line Load, a 1kN Concentrated Load and a 400J swing bag test. The balustrade underwent the three tests and no permanent deformation was observed and thus the balustrade was deemed to be satisfactory for Areas outlined in areas categories A, B, C1-C4, D and E described in Table 1 of SANS 10160-2.
